Core Values & Legislative Platform

Faith & Freedom

Carlin believes that defending liberty is a core responsibility of the Christian faith. He emphasizes the importance of upholding religious freedoms and moral integrity in governance.

Pro-Life Advocacy

As a state senator, Carlin co-led the effort to pass Iowa's Heartbeat Bill, one of the nation's earliest and most stringent pro-life laws, demonstrating his commitment to protecting the unborn.

America First Policies

Carlin supports securing the U.S. border, repatriating manufacturing, and implementing tariff equity to strengthen the national economy. He was a strong advocate for passing lowa's sanctuary cities ban, reflecting his stance on immigration and national security.

Constitutional Integrity

He opposes corporate overreach and government mandates that infringe upon individual rights, such as privacy, private property, health insurance and vaccination requirements. Carlin advocates for a constitutional amendment to overturn Citizens United and eliminate super PACs, aiming to reduce undue influence in politics.

Veterans' Advocacy

Carlin exposed the mismanagement of the \$30 million Iowa Veterans Trust Fund, leading to reforms that significantly increased its annual revenue for veterans. He also brought attention to elder abuse at the Iowa Veterans Home, resulting in corrective actions.

Restoring Liberty

He founded the Iowa Liberty Network to recruit and support constitutional conservative candidates, providing them with training, mentorship, and resources to effect change within the state legislature.
